BQC00026 – What To Do if Boveda Leaks onto Cannabis Flower

Standard Troubleshooting Guide

All Boveda formulations are produced using food grade ingredients, e.g. Food Chemicals Codex grade salt, gum, and water. If a Boveda sachet leaks and the leakage comes into contact with cannabis flower, it will not harm the flower or the user. However, the flower may not be desirable to smoke due to the salt in our formula.

If there is a small amount of salt residue, allow the residue to dry, then brush it away.

For a larger quantity of salt residue, rinsing the flower that has come into contact with the contents of a leaking Boveda sachet will wash away the salt, but rinsing may damage the flower.

Obviously, the final decision is up to the consumer, but Boveda suggests discarding the flower and obtaining fresh flower to use.
